Recertification Credit*

Board certified pharmacists are eligible to receive 3.5 contact hours of recertification credit for completing this module. To earn recertification credit, learners must review the activity content and successfully complete the online assessment by the deadline. Only completed assessments will be eligible for credit; no partial or incomplete assessments will be processed. You are allowed only one attempt to successfully complete this assessment.

Participants who pass the assessments will be eligible for recertification credit in the year in which the assessment was completed.
